- Importance for future generations

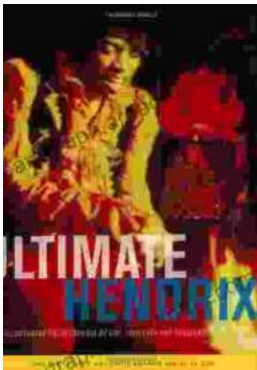

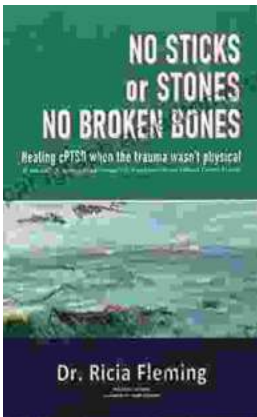
