






Microscopic view of tuberculosis bacteria



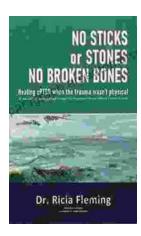
